Albion Spring Clean-Up Saturday, May 13, 2023

Clean up will begin at 6:00 am & continue until Noble County Disposal goes through the entire town. Items need to be at the curb by 6:00 am (NO ALLEY PICKUPS). NCD will go down each street ONCE. There will be no backtracking for late items being put at the curb.

APPLIANCES – NO CHARGE for appliances <u>without Freon</u> (washers, dryers, dishwashers, microwave ovens, hot water heaters, etc.). Items containing FREON will cost \$70.00 each (refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, etc.).

ELECTRONICS – A drop off site for electronics will be available at the Albion Municipal Building located at 211 E. Park Dr, Albion. Items may be dropped off on Saturday, May 13th from 6:30 am-10:30 am ONLY. You must show a water bill or another utility bill as proof of town residency. Noble County Disposal **WILL NOT** pick up electronic items such as computers, printers, VCRs, stereos, televisions, DVD & CD players at the curb.

<u>Tires</u> – \$10.00 each for 16" or smaller WITHOUT RIMS

\$15.00 each for 16" or smaller WITH RIMS \$15.00 each for 17" or larger WITHOUT RIMS \$20.00 each for 17" or larger WITH RIMS

\$20.00 each for all tractor tires (WITH OR WITHOUT RIMS)

Wood – cut into 4-foot pieces and bundled so that it can be handled easily.

Carpet – needs to be in 4-foot rolls and tied.



No construction materials or hazardous materials (wet paint, oil, household cleaners, etc.). No yard waste, concrete, electronics, fluorescent bulbs, normal household trash, roofing and/or other construction materials.

Due to escalating costs for providing curbside service, the size of disposals piles for pickup will be limited to an area **NO LARGER THAN 8' X 8' X 4'.**

This service is for residential taxpayers of the Town of Albion. Please help us control costs by not allowing items to be brought in from outside of Town limits. The future of this program depends on you.

ITEMS REQUIRING PAYMENT

Items requiring payment must be paid at the Albion Municipal Building, 211 E. Park Dr. and tagged prior to spring cleanup. You will need to make the payment before 4 pm on Friday, May 12, 2023.

NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN FOR ITEMS TAKEN OFF THE STREET PRIOR TO SPRING CLEANUP. NO EXCEPTIONS.
